2 Basic Operations

2.1 Switching the Device On/Off

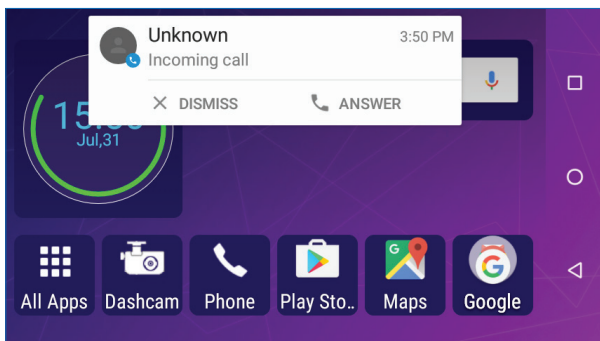
If the device is connected to the ignition, the device can be turned on/off automatically using the ignition switch. For manual operation press and hold the Power Button. Notice that the Tablet should be powered off to remove the SIM.

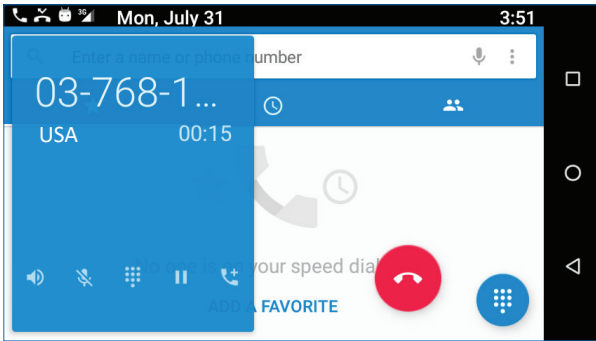
2.2 Home Screens

You can place your favorite applications on the Home screen. To add an application touch .

Long press the app icon you want to add to the Home screen. Drag the icon to a position on one of the Home screens and lift your finger. To discard the icon from the Home screen, drag the icon to the **X** in the corner.


2.3 Receiving a Call







When receiving a call, the device's view screen will change its display and show incoming call details.

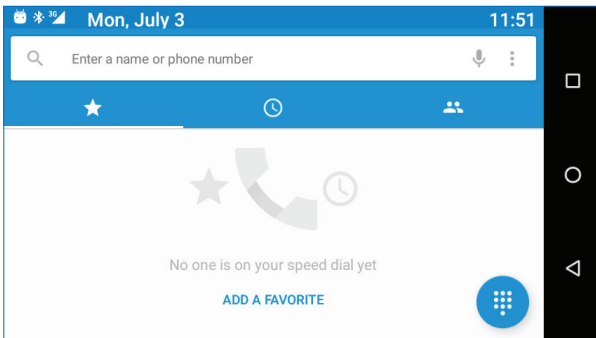
To accept the call, press  **ANSWER** on the phone, or swipe the screen to the right.



To reject the call (or to disconnect after completing the call) press  **DISMISS** on the phone, or swipe the screen to the left.

2.4 Making a Call

2.4.1 Making a Call Using the Keyboard






Enter a name or phone number or press  and then .

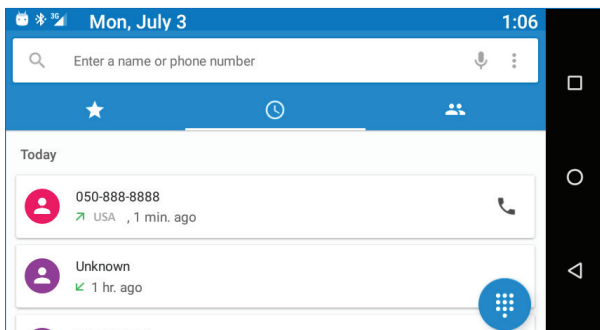



Enter in the desired number using the keyboard. To correct a dialed number, touch . Press  to make the call.

To disconnect after completing the call, press  on the screen.

2.4.2 Making a Call from the Call Log

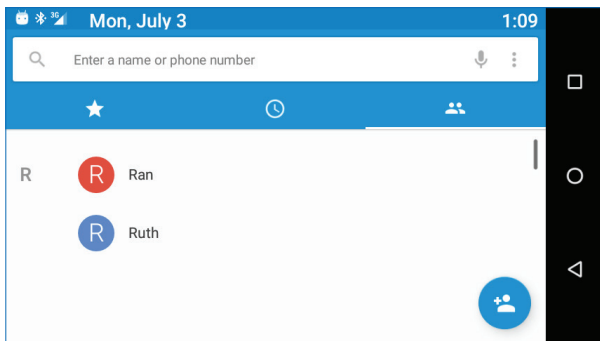
Press . Touch  to view the last calls: missed calls , outgoing calls , incoming calls . The Call log displays the last calls made.



Scroll the list and touch  near the name you want to call.

2.4.3 Making a Call from the Contacts List

Touch  to open the Contacts list.




After locating the contact, touch the record and touch the number you want to call.

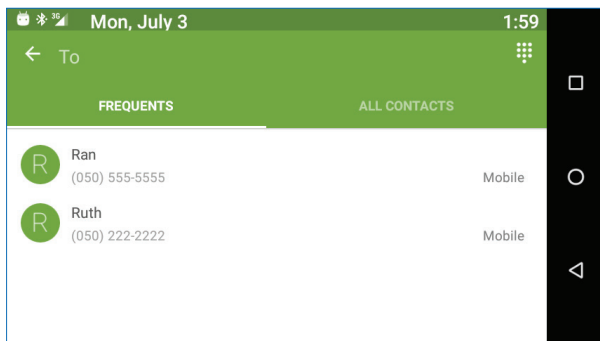
2.5 SMS

Drive safely! Check and abide by all applicable laws.

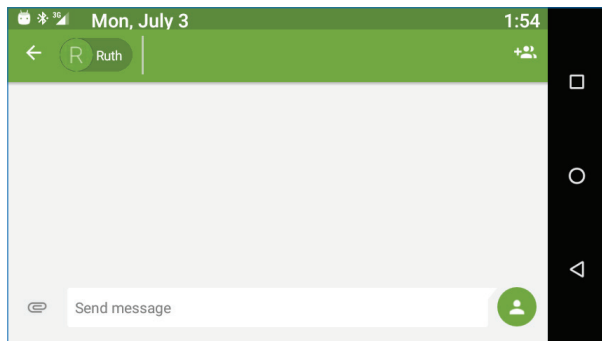
You can send and receive SMS (Short Message Service).


Touch  to enter the SMS screen.

Touch  to start a new message.



Type the phone number in the 'To' field or choose a contact.





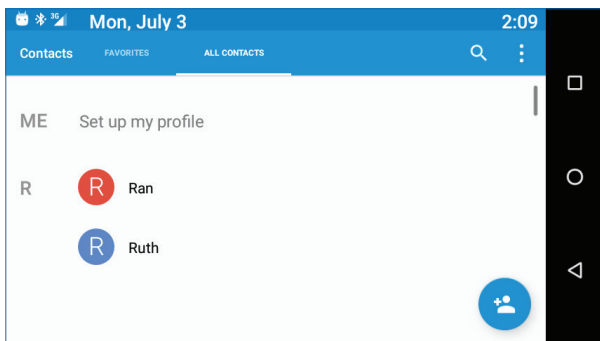
Type your message in the 'Send message' field. You can attach a file – click .

2.5.1 Edit Text


You can edit the text you have entered. Click the text you wish to edit, the selected text will be highlighted in green. Drag the highlighting tab to change the range of your selection. A menu will display the options. Choose one of the options: Cut, Copy, Paste, Share, Select all, Assist.

Touch  from **All App** or  from **Phone** to open the Contacts list:

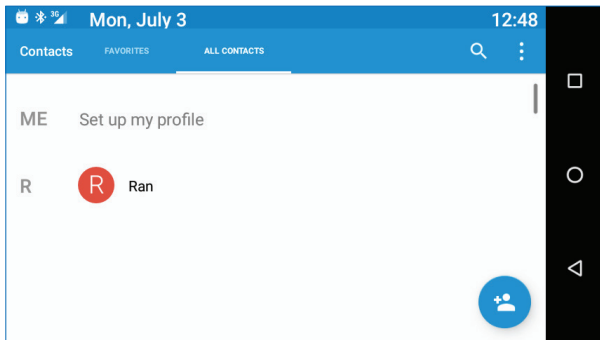


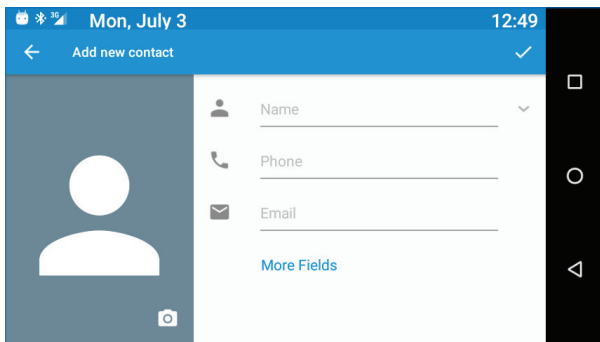
3.1 Search for a Contact

Slide with your finger up/down to find a contact, or touch  to search by name.

Touch  to add a new contact.

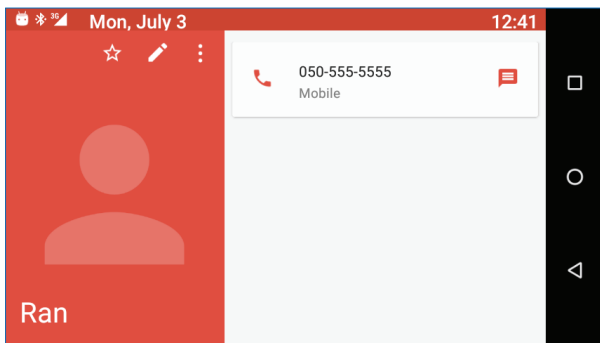





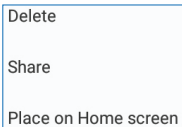
Fill in the fields. Touch  to save.

3.3 Edit a Contact

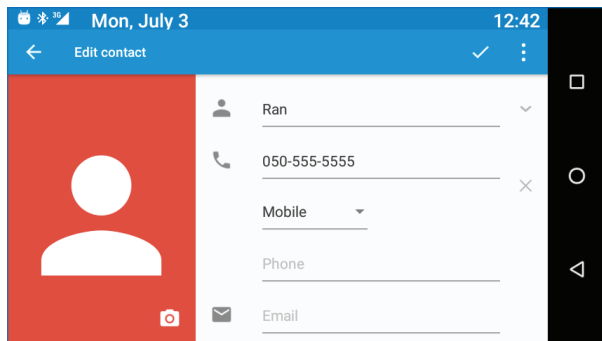
Slide with your finger up/down to find a contact. Select the one you need.




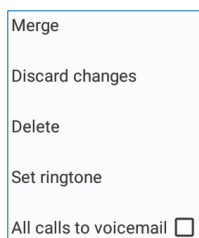
Touch  to get more options.



Touch  and Edit.



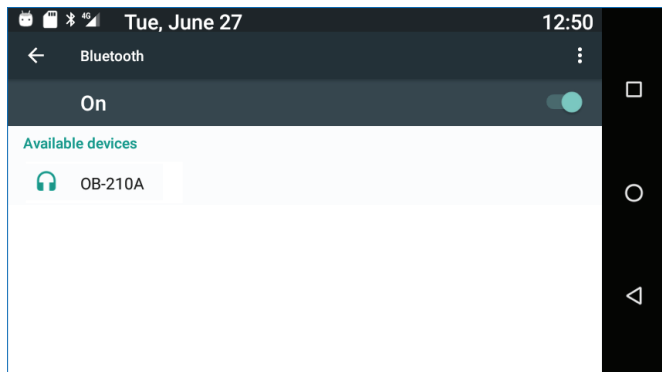

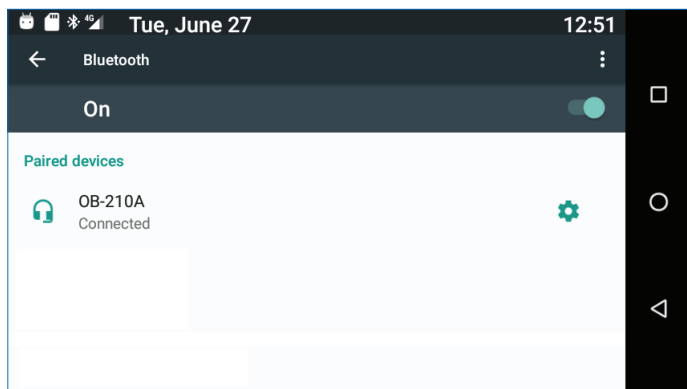

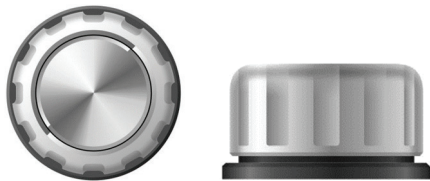
4 Using the BT Control Button

The BT control button is a circular knob with 3 operational options. To connect to BT, choose OB-210A. The connection will be automatic and without the need for any password.



After connecting to BT audio will be through an external speaker and microphone.





4.1 Pressing the Button

Pressing down on the button can be used for several functions.

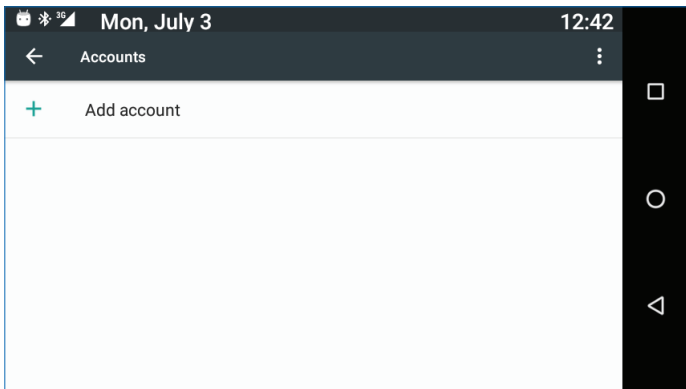
1. If pairing of the BT unit is needed, press the button for a period of 5 seconds and pairing mode will be initiated.
2. Answer an incoming call.
3. End a call.

Note: The device is already paired, but in case of communication problems it may be necessary to pair it again.

4.2 Rotating the Button

1. Rotating Clockwise during a call will increase the volume.
2. Rotating Counterclockwise during a call will decrease the volume.

5 Accounts



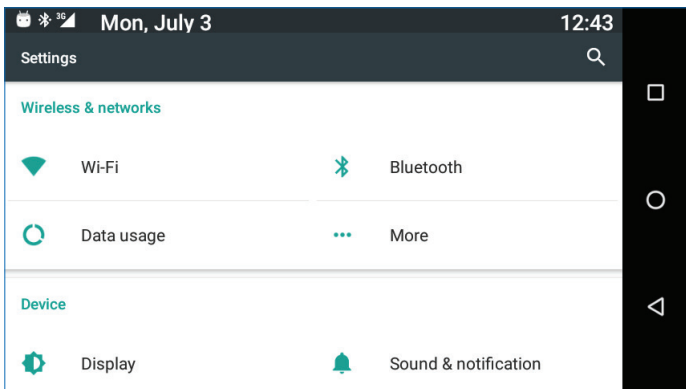
Sign up with an email address to sign in to Google, Mail and Play Store, and more.

Touch **Settings, Accounts** and select **Add Account**.

Note that this feature requires an active Internet connection.

If you have not opened a new account, when you log in to Google for the first time, it will ask you to sign up with your email address.

6 Settings Menu



The Settings menu includes all application and phone menu settings.

On the main screen, touch **All Apps**  and  to open the Settings menu.
